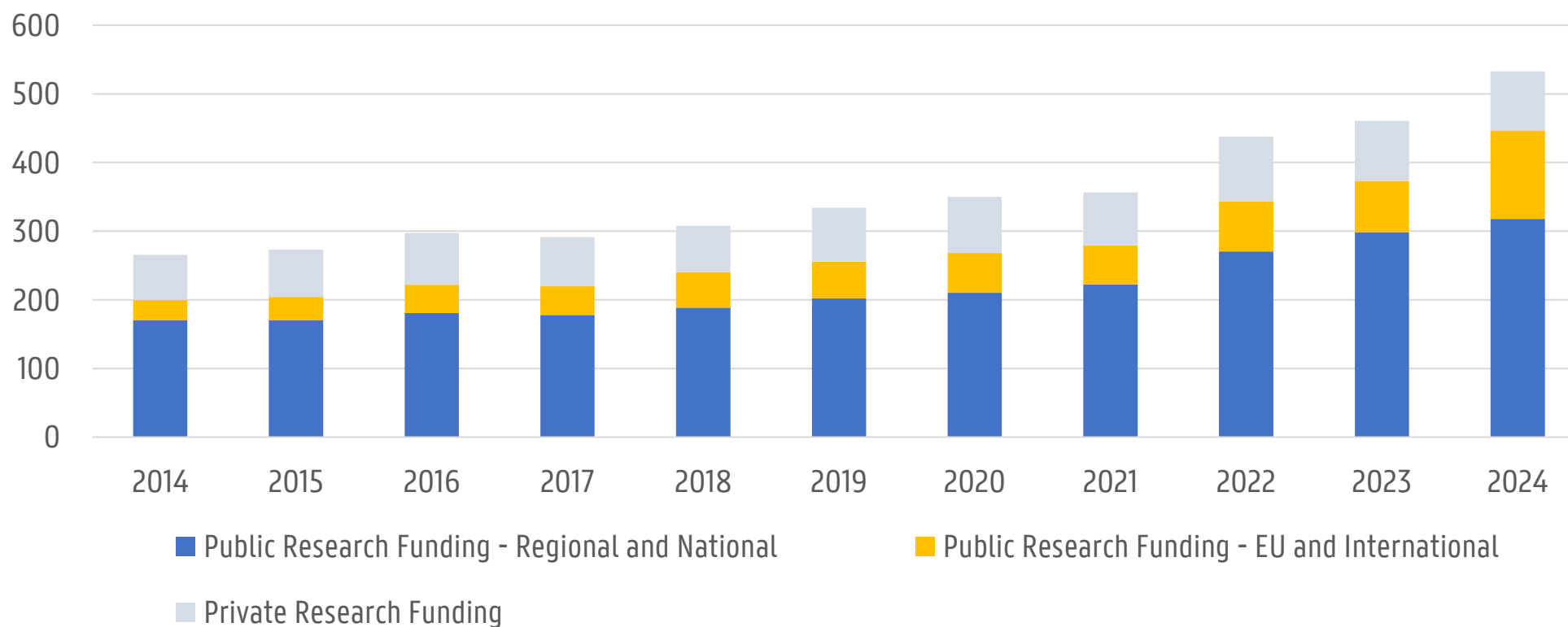

Driven by its true nature of rebellion and quirkiness, Ghent experiments with innovative policies.

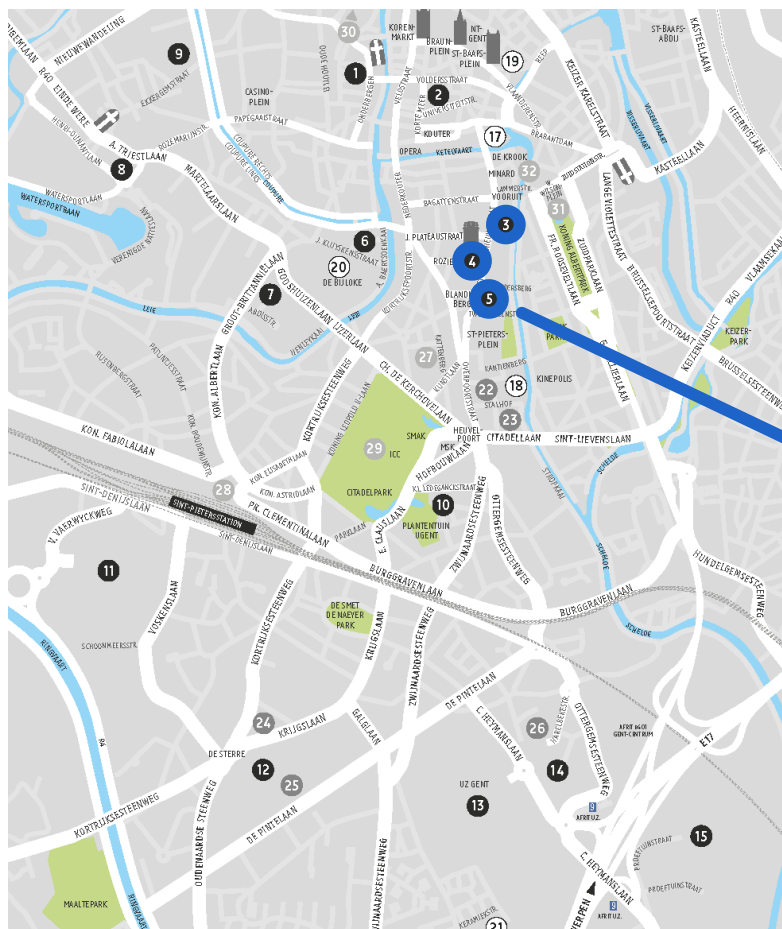
